### CLASSES

1. Junior Level: A Junior dog may be restrained at the line and must return to the line but need not deliver to hand.
2. Open Level: All dogs that have run in a NAHRA intermediate test, a NAHRA senior test, an AKC senior test, and/or an AKC master test are considered Open dogs for purposes of Super Singles. Open dogs must be steady at the line with no restraint and must deliver to hand.

Dogs in both levels will be graded on their marking ability and style. Every dog runs all marks (three land, three water). Two live flyers per dog guaranteed. Scores will be posted after each series. Scoring criteria is attached. No electric collars.

There will also be a potluck BBQ lunch. CCHRC will provide meat, and we request that you bring a dish to share (appetizers, salads, desserts, beverages). Please BYO water for yourself and your dogs.

## SUPER SINGLES MARATHON SCORING FORMULA

All dogs in both classes will be scored by the judges using the following formula:

- 10 Pinned mark.
- 9 Winds bird and hooks into the mark.
- 8 Short hunt, stays in area of the mark.
- 7 Hunting to the mark with nose down.
- 6 Medium hunt, hunt covering large area.
- 5 Long hunt in area, has trouble finding mark.
- 4 Gets lost, leaves area but comes back to find mark.
- 3 Cheats test by avoiding water or cover.
- 2 S.O.B. – stumbles on bird.
- 1 No clue, but finds mark.
- 0 Handled to mark or verbally assisted.

All dogs will be judged on marking and style.

### DIRECTIONS from Highway 101 North/South

- ✓ Highway 101 to San Miguel exit (approximately 9 miles north of Paso Robles)
- ✓ Go through San Miguel approximately 0.8 miles and turn right on River Road.
- ✓ Proceed about 0.6 miles on River road, over the bridge, and turn left on Cross Canyon Road.
- ✓ Immediately turn left onto Indian Valley Road. After about 1.3 miles, bear right onto Vineyard Canyon Road. Proceed on Vineyard Canyon Road approximately 17.8 miles.
- ✓ At T-intersection, turn right. You will be on Vineyard Canyon Road.
- ✓ After approximately 4.4 miles, Vineyard Canyon Road becomes Cholame Road (bear right).
- ✓ *Before* you get to a narrow green bridge on Cholame Road, you will see a bunch of mailboxes on your right at a dirt road.
- ✓ Turn right onto the dirt road, and follow the signs to the Super Singles site.

### DIRECTIONS from Highway 46/41

- ✓ Take Parkfield turn-off, which is Cholame Valley Road. This becomes Cholame Road after about 16 miles.
- ✓ After passing over the narrow green bridge, you will see a bunch of mailboxes on your left. Turn left onto the dirt road, and follow the signs to the Super Singles site.
